- Keep work stations clear and tidy
- Wrap or place merchandise in bags or boxes for customers
- Count back tills at closing of shift and reconcile all payments and ensure all documents accounted for
- Stock shelves and ensure proper rotation is done
- Price items where needed
- Direct customers to location of product for articles sought and inform managers of all
- Customer requests and any complaints
- Proper checking of invoices and stock received at front-end and that the documents are handed in to the office after they have been checked and signed for.
