POSITION SUMMARY: Two (2) summer students will co-ordinate and implement a weekly Environmental Youth Group geared towards co-ed children ages 8 – 12 years. Some of the activities will incorporate traditional knowledge of our Elders. Other activities will include learning field trips and/or workshops with our Species at Risk experts. Students will also be required to participate in the Youth Centre and surrounding areas general maintenance and First Nation Sports and Recreation activities. The students will be required to complete a final report to summarize project activities and benefits to the participants and community.

PRIMARY DUTIES:

- Ability to work with children ages 8-12 years of age
- A good knowledge of the First Nation community and culture
- Must be creative, patient, and dependable and also possess outdoor skills
- Must possess organizational and time management skills
- Shift work
- Strong verbal and written communication
- Ability to handle multiple responsibilities in a professional manner
- Ability to take initiative as circumstances arise
- General indoor/outdoor maintenance skills
- General computer skills

EDUCATION/PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a registered band member of the Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation
- High School/Post-Secondary Education
- Must be returning to school in September 2017; proof of enrolment required
- Must provide a clear CPIC
- Be between the ages of 15 and 29 years
- Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation gives preference to First Nation applicants for any employment opportunities as per Section 16(1) of the Canadian Human Rights Act.
