

# CONS of a Land Code

## *CONS*

FN will take full responsibility for all future decision making & if wrong decisions are made, could be liable

Cannot blame anyone else if future mistakes are made

Training – will be a priority, thus staff & financial resources will have to be made available

There is no turning back to the Indian Act to get INAC to take over land decision making

Community readiness – Is the community ready for its own FN decision making?

Council/Staff experience – Does Council & Staff feel up to the task to be full decision makers?

Typical growing pains of any government: Sufficient resources, Staff, Space, Policy & procedural development, Law making

Lots of hard work will be required
