- Must be able to function as part of a team
- Knowledge regarding the Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation
- Skills and knowledge to support the management process of the Committee
- Preference given to Kettle and Stony Point Band members
- Must be able to attend meetings on a regular basis

Time Parameters:

- Term of this position will be until the next Band Council election
- Minimum of one Health Committee meeting per month
- Special events such as orientation, training, conferences, planning sessions, etc. will be in addition to regular meetings schedule and will vary in time requirements
