NOTICE TO THE MEMBERSHIP

Council has approved the date of AUGUST 3, 2018 for the General Band Election, for a two year term under the Indian Act Election Regulations. Nominations will be held on JUNE 22, 2018.

The current term, although previously established to June 23, 2019, will now end once the new Council is confirmed at the official community ceremony. Also, all Board and Committee positions will be reposted this year. External Board and Committee members will be individually advised of the status of their term except those filled by Council members.

Chief and Council will continue in their capacity for community governance, but will not be dealing with external government matters as Indigenous Services Canada (formerly INAC) will not recognize the authority of Council beyond June 23, 2018.
