(Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point)


Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the electors of the Kettle & Stony Point First Nation will be held at the Kettle & Stony Point Hillside School gym on Friday, June 22, 2018 from the hours of 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the positions of chief and councillors on the Band Council for the Kettle and Stony Point First Nation, for the next ensuing term.

There will be 9 (nine) councillor positions and 1 (one) position for chief to be filled by election process.

The election will be held at the Kettle & Stony Point Hillside School gym, on Friday, August 3, 2018 from the hours of 9:00 am to 8:00 pm (local time). An elector (voter) is any registered member of the Kettle & Stony Point First Nation who will be at least 18 years of age on August 3, 2018.

Please note that any voter may nominate candidates by using a mail-in nomination form. You can either deliver or mail-in a written nomination and a completed, signed and witnessed voter declaration form to the electoral officer before the time set for the nomination meeting OR you may nominate candidates at the nomination meeting on June 22, 2018. Mailed nominations not received by the electoral officer before the close of the nomination meeting will be void.
