UPCOMING GENERAL ELECTION OF CHIEF AND COUNCILLORS ON AUGUST 3, 2018

Hello Electors:

Nominations for the positions of Chief and Councillors was held on June 22, 2018.

Ballots were prepared and mailed out to our off-reserve electors on June 29 (for whom we have an updated address).

Under the Election Regulations (Indian Act) ballots must be prepared and sent out to the off-reserve electors by a certain date, to allow them time to cast their ballots, and return them before the close of the poll on August 3.

This is to advise that candidates however have up until the close of the poll on August 3rd to still withdraw their names if they choose. Their name remains on the ballot because the ballots we provide at the poll must be the same ballots that were mailed out to off-reserve electors on June 29th. For any candidate who does withdraw their name after ballots are printed, then we do not count any votes cast in their favor.

This is further to advise any candidates who may now want to withdraw their name, that I am not permitted to inform electors for you. I HAVE PROVIDED A SPACE ON THE BOARD IN THE FRONT LOBBY OF ADMINISTRATION OFFICE and should you submit a withdraw to myself, you can post it on the board as well for electors to view.
