Peer Diabetes Prevention Worker**

Job Summary

As part of the collaborative care team at the Kettle and Stony Point Health Centre, the worker will work in cooperation with the North Lambton Community Health Centre Diabetes Education program as we work in partnership to provide community health promotion and prevention services. The worker will assist with diabetes screening events, provide education about risk factors and prevention of type 2 diabetes and aid in programs aimed at increasing access to physical activity, healthy eating and other basic skills.

Job Duties

- Participate in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs and projects that relate to the strategies identified in the Ontario Diabetes Strategy
- Facilitate cooking and physical activity group classes
- Increase community awareness of programs designed to increase access to physical activity and the consumption of healthy food.
- The peer worker will be responsible for gathering and submitting regular reports to the KSPH management and the Diabetes Coordinator at the NLCHC (part of current data collection process).
- The peer worker must be able to function effectively with all chronic disease management and health promotion teams to collectively provide comprehensive programs in the community and promote healthy lifestyles.
- The peer worker must engage in regular dialogue with the Diabetes Coordinator to ensure continuity of services.

Education and Experience

- Grade 12 as per Band Policy (must provide proof)
- Training/certification in nutrition, cooking and physical activity would be assets
- Knowledge and skills related to nutrition and physical activities
- Relevant experience in First Nations health in the areas of health promotion and prevention.
