Pathways Health Centre for Children is a family-centred community agency serving children and youth with physical, developmental and communication needs and their families as well as adults for selected specialized services in Lambton County. The Centre provides a full range of family-centred rehabilitation and support services. Aquatic programs in our therapeutic pool are open to people of all ages and abilities in the community. There is also an integrated childcare service (C.A.C.H.E.) on site.

We are currently recruiting for a:

- Physiotherapist to be part of a team delivering services with our First Nations partners.

The successful candidate will begin with a contract for September, 2018 to March 31, 2019.

Working under the direction of the Clinical Services Manager and in partnership with a First Nations team, the Physiotherapist will provide screening, assessment and intervention supports to clients referred through the First Nations Partnership. The role may also include: consultation, counseling and education to families, primary caregivers, schools and the community.
