- See all aspects of policing
- Obtain first hand understanding of the dispatch procedures
- Observe how records are prepared and processed
- Attend a three-day stay at the Ontario Police College, shadowing a Police Recruit with their classes
- Follow the Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation Employee Policy Manual

EDUCATION/PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a registered band member of the Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation
- High School or Post-Secondary Student
- Must be returning to full time school in the fall, proof of enrollment required
- Must provide a clear CPIC
- Be between the ages of 18 and 20 years
- No criminal conviction for which a pardon has not been granted
- Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation gives preference to First Nation applicants for any employment opportunities as per Section 16(1) of the Canadian Human Rights Act.
