LEADERSHIP SELECTION CODE (ELECTION CODE)

The Governance Initiatives Committee has held several community consultation sessions, seeking input into the draft Leadership Selection Code (Election Code). Those sessions were held throughout the months of September 2018 to March 2019. The sessions and questionnaires were also posted through video recording on the First Nation's website.

→ The four questionnaires that were provided at the consultation meetings have now been combined into one questionnaire for anyone who has not completed one and wishes to do so.

We are continuing with the final stages of consultation during the month of May. A representative for the committee will be going door-to-door on the First Nation with the questionnaire. We welcome your participation by completing a questionnaire when the representative comes, or arranges with you a more convenient time for you to sit and ask questions. This will occur throughout the month of May.

You can also pick one up at the Administration Office rather than doing a door-to-door with the representative.

Any elector who resides away from the First Nation may also participate in the questionnaire and we welcome you to do so. We can mail, email, fax or complete a questionnaire over the phone upon your request before the end of May 2019.
