The Sixties Scoop Class Action Lawsuit was finally resolved in October of 2017, and the official implementation date is December 1, 2018. If you or anyone you know identifies as a survivor of the 60's Scoop you will need to fill out an Individual Payment Application Form and sign it in two different places.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: AUGUST 30, 2019
