Indian Day School update

May 5, 2020

There have been inquiries from members regarding the impact the Indian Day School settlement may have on those receiving Ontario Works/Disability Assistance.

Gowlings has stated:

“There will be no impact on Ontario Works, Social Assistance, Old Age Security and the like. This is a key term of our negotiated settlement. Canada has committed to working with each province to carve out exclusions in the respective jurisdictions. The compensation is also not taxable.”
