

NOTICE of RATIFICATION VOTE

KETTLE & STONY POINT FIRST NATION ELECTORS

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Kettle and Stony Point First Nation that a RATIFICATION VOTE will be held to determine if the electors are in favor of the final settlement of the **Clench Defalcation Specific Claim**.

An elector is any band member of the Kettle and Stony Point First Nation who will be at least 18 years of age on or before November 13, 2020.

The ratification vote will be held on **Friday, November 13, 2020** from the hours of **9:00 am to 8:00 pm** at the **Kettle and Stony Point Hillside School gym**, Kettle and Stony Point First Nation, Ontario.

THE QUESTION THAT WILL BE ASKED OF THE ELECTORS ON THE BALLOT WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

As a Voter of the First Nation, do you:

- (a) Agree to all of the terms and conditions of the Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation Clench Defalcation Specific Claim Settlement Agreement initialed by the negotiators for the First Nation and Canada, which settles and releases the Claim;
- AND
- (b) Authorize and direct the Council of the First Nation to sign all documents and do everything necessary to give effect to the Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation Clench Defalcation Specific Claim Settlement Agreement?

YES or NO

(you will be asked to chose one of these two options on the ballot)

There will be three methods of voting that electors can chose from to cast their ballot in this ratification vote.

- 1. Vote in person at the poll on November 13, 2020 between the hours of 9am and 8pm.**
- 2. Vote by mail-in ballot method and return your mail-in ballot to the ratification officer before the close of the poll on November 13, 2020 at 8pm.**
- 3. Vote by electronic voting method by entering the electronic voting site at <https://www.onefeather.ca/nations/kettlestonypoint> and following the instructions. (The electronic vote site will not open until Monday, October 5, 2020)**

The counting of the votes will not commence until the following day on November 14, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. and the result will then be announced, posted at the place of vote and posted on the First Nation's website as well as on the electronic voting site.
