

POLLING NOTICE

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Kettle and Stony Point First Nation that a poll will be held to elect one (1) Chief and nine (9) Councillors to the Kettle and Stony Point First Nation Council.

Such poll will be held on Friday, November 13, 2020 from the hours of 9:00 am to 8:00 pm at the Kettle and Stony Point Hillside School gym, Kettle and Stony Point First Nation, Ontario.

The votes will be counted at the Kettle and Stony Point Hillside School gym on Saturday, November 14, 2020 and the results will be declared immediately following the count. The new council term will begin immediately after the results are announced on November 14, 2020.

Please note that safety and health precautions will be applied at the place of poll on vote day. Health screening will be mandatory and all persons entering will be required to wear a mask. Only 'electors' will be permitted to enter the polling room (gym).

I encourage you to vote by mail-in ballot. This vote does not offer the electronic voting method (it is held under the provisions of the Indian Act which does not offer such method and offers either voting in person or by mail-in ballot).
