**Attention:** Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation Residents and Lessees

To continue to protect our lands, environment, and water for future generations, this is a reminder that the Environmental Protection Station ("Dump") is meant to be accessible to Band Members for recycling only and for Lessees basic household waste. Proper distribution of solid waste and recycling is of the utmost importance to the First Nation. Improper dumping on the First Nation is illegal. Solid Waste is meant to be curbside pickup only, objects such as: appliances, furniture, household items, etc. are not permitted. This is also a reminder that the Lessees who pay for the Environmental Protection Station service have access to the monitored station with limited access on Fridays and Sundays (and Holiday Mondays) from 10:00am to 2:00pm. Band Members who utilize the recycling services have access to the station on these days and this excludes Businesses.
