Purpose of Committee

The purpose is to work in partnership with the Health Centre, the community, and our leadership to deliver health services consistent with the needs of the community and based upon values, guiding principles and current health policies and procedures

Summary of Duties

- Work in partnership with the Health Centre, the community, and community leadership in a relationship of mutual trust and respect.
- Be open and respectful to community cultural norms and practices in terms of integrated, holistic health care/mental wellness practices and treatment models.
- Being aware of community partnerships in the provision of quality health care practice, research, and education.
- Promote and facilitate positive communication between the health centre, Chief and Council, other Band programs and the community.
- Stay abreast of current, proposed and future health related issues from all levels of government (local, provincial and national)
- On a regular basis and in conjunction with management, review policies and procedures related to the delivery of health services.
- Report to Chief and Council on issues related to health and mental wellness and make recommendations as required based upon communication with health services
- Utilizing evidence based research together with current best practices grounded in holistic concepts of health and wellness, strive to effectively serve the best interests of the Kettle and Stony Point Band membership.

Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age
- Grade 12 (or equivalent) recommended
- Must be able to function as part of the team
- Must be open-minded to various concepts of holistic health and wellness programming.
- Possess skills and knowledge to support the processes involved in the Committee work
- Preference given to Band members of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation

Time Parameters

- Term of the position will be until next Band election (normally a 2- year term)
- Meetings to be held once per month
- Special events such as orientation, training, conferences, planning sessions will be in addition to the regular meeting schedule
