Committee Membership Posting

Chief and Council are seeking four (4) community members for the newly established Indigenous Language and Culture Committee. The term runs parallel with the Council term. Meetings will be held once per month.

Goal Statement: The Indigenous Language Committee will support Council's direction that a sustainable Indigenous culture and language strategy be developed, implemented and be guided by Community Vision and Strategic Plan.

Responsibilities

- To create and promote an environment reflecting language, traditions, culture and values conducive to language learning;
- To consider the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada "Calls to Action" and the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous People;
- To establish goals and objectives based on and in support of the First Nation's Community Vision and Strategic Plan; to provide guidance to the assigned program and service area
- To ensure work plans and activities are reflective of CKSP needs and funding availability;
- To serve interest and needs of the CKSP community as a whole;
- To assist in identifying and providing support to staff in securing funding and/or other required resources for community initiatives as required;
- To review budgets and ensure adherence to approved budgets;
- Provide input into policy development relating to language and culture.

Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older;
- Must be a member of the Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation;
- A good knowledge of Anishnabemowin and culture
- Must sign and adhere to the KSPFN Code of Ethics and the Confidentiality Form;
- Be in good financial standing with the First Nation

Term of Office: Two years or as designated by Council
