RE: The Big Dirt Hill

Due to the ground work that was required to build the water tower and develop the surrounding area for housing, a large amount of clay has been piled and needs to be moved. This is a notice to all band members that the hill will be open to access to everyone for the month of July.

Anyone who wishes to obtain dirt from the hill must sign a waiver before digging. The hill will be available to access during regular administration work hours – Monday to Friday – 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. Should you require assistance, the PUC department can be contracted out at a cost of \$75.00 per load. Only one person or their group can access the hill at one time for the purposes of safety and COVID safety.

If you would like to attend the site to obtain material, please contact Mel Bressette at the Band Office to make arrangements, sign the waiver and pre-pay if required.

At the beginning of August, whatever remains of the hill will be moved to the old Kettle Point dump.
