- Adhere to the Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation Employment Manual.
- Must be a positive role model to students through a healthy lifestyle.

Education/Professional Requirements:

- Grade 12 diploma
- Must have a current Class "B" School Bus Driver's License as per Ministry of Transportation of Ontario regulations.
- Must demonstrate a good driving record and provide Driver Abstract yearly.
- Successful completion of a Driver Improvement Safety course.
- Successful completion of Emergency First Aid course.
- Clear CPIC and Vulnerable Sector Screening;
- Previous experience driving a school bus preferred.

Preferential Hiring Requirements:

- KSPFN encourages all qualified individuals to apply. However, preference will be given to qualified First Nations people in accordance with KSPFN' General Principles of the Human Resource Management Policy, section 16 of the Canadian Human Rights Act, sub-section 24(1)(a) of the Ontario Human Rights Code, and section 7 of the Employment Equity Act. First Nations candidates who wish to qualify for preferential consideration can self-identify themselves in their cover letter.
- Successful applicants must provide a current and up-to-date CPIC and vulnerable sector background check upon hiring.
- Successful applicant must provide a copy of their Diploma and other related certificates.
- Applicants must consent to a full background check upon hiring.
