## Program Label: Summer Student Employment

### Eligible students

- Currently full-time high school or post-secondary and returning to school full time.
- Kettle & Stony Point band member
- 15 – 30 years old

### Eligible employer

- Non- profit organizations
- Public sector employers
- First nations council
- Private sector business

### Eligible placements

- 6 – 16 weeks (For profit up to 50% wage subsidy) 25 - 40 hours per week
- 6 – 16 weeks (Not for profit up to 100% wage subsidy) 25 - 40 hours per week

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All employers will be responsible for submissions to be fully completed before review. The following is what will be needed for a completed application.

- **Expected results**
- **Budget results**
- **Application for funding (attached)**
- **Request letter**
