

It's Back for 2022

Community Clean-Up

May - 26, 27

June – 2, 3 & June - 9, 10

Enter through the Public Works Department entrance

9390 Centre side rd. Kettle & Stony Point F.N.

Waste drop off time will be from 9-11am 1pm-330pm each day, Late arrivals will not be accepted until the following drop off date.

In response to Covid-19, Kettle & Stony Point will be accepting waste drop off for the Community Clean Up this year instead of the previous curbside collection method.

Dumpsters will be dropped off behind the Public Work Building to accommodate the community clean up and allow for public works to monitor the bins more closely.

Proof of residency will be required when paying for your spring clean-up

Public Works Staff will be on site to receive your waste and verify that you have paid the finance department.

Public Works staff will also be able to answer questions that you may have on which items will not be accepted

Cost will be \$35.00 for a pick-up truck load, with a \$20.00 minimum fee for small loads and individual items. Example – car trunk load, appliance, furniture.

If you are unable to get your items to the roads dept, for a \$15 fee the Public Works will come to your location and receive the items – Items must be outside in bags/boxes limited to 2 front

backhoe bucket loads. You must have someone to load items.

Items that will be Accepted:

renovation debris,
Yard Waste,
Household Garbage,
Mattresses, Furniture
Scrap metal, cut into reasonable length
Tires will be accepted this year

Items that will not be accepted:

Paints, Solvents, Chemicals
Flammable or Explosive materials
Compressed Gas Cylinders
Refrigeration items
