

Stony Point Community Development Program: Community Planning Survey

As you may know, in 2019 Hatch, an engineering and project management consulting firm, was engaged by CKSPFN. In 2020 and 2021, this engagement successfully delivered the Stony Point Temporary Housing Project. Now that the Temporary Housing Project has been completed, Hatch is beginning community consultation for the next phase of engagement. The purpose of this survey is to gain the widest possible input from all those who identify with Aazhoodena/Stony Point to guide us on the journey of reestablishing the community on the land. This will include exploring infrastructure options and community development which includes housing. In the short term, we are working with the community to best understand the housing and infrastructure needs and interest at Stony Point. As we start this process, we would be grateful for your help in sharing information on your views. Feedback should not be restricted just to answering questions: everyone can provide whatever input they like as part of the survey. Everyone's input is important and valuable – please share all your ideas. The deadline for submission of the survey is within the next 30 days by October 4, 2022. Upon completion and submission of your survey, your name will be added to a draw to win one of three \$50 dollar Visa gift cards.

Please note that in answering these questions we are not determining who will and will not be part of the housing development. At this stage we are interested in understanding the circumstances around your interest in coming back to the community to determine recommendations on how to best roll out permanent housing and community infrastructure options.

The answers you provide will not be shared outside the immediate project team. Information collected will be analyzed and high-level outcomes and trends will be shared with CKSPFN decision-makers. If you choose to provide us with your contact information at the end of the survey it will only be utilized for the purposes of the community development communication and not provided to anyone outside the immediate project team.

Thank you for taking the time (approximately 5-10min) to provide your input and for helping us understand how Stony Point community development can be planned and developed in a fair way to allow all those who want to, to return home. Future outreach will focus on building upon the collective vision for community development and infrastructure at Stony Point.
