- * Must have technical abilities to join meetings virtually if needed
- * Must be a member of the Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation
- * Must sign the Chippewas of Kettle & Stony Point First Nation Code of Ethics and Confidentiality Agreement and adhere to the guidelines throughout their term and after where required (i.e. Confidentiality).
