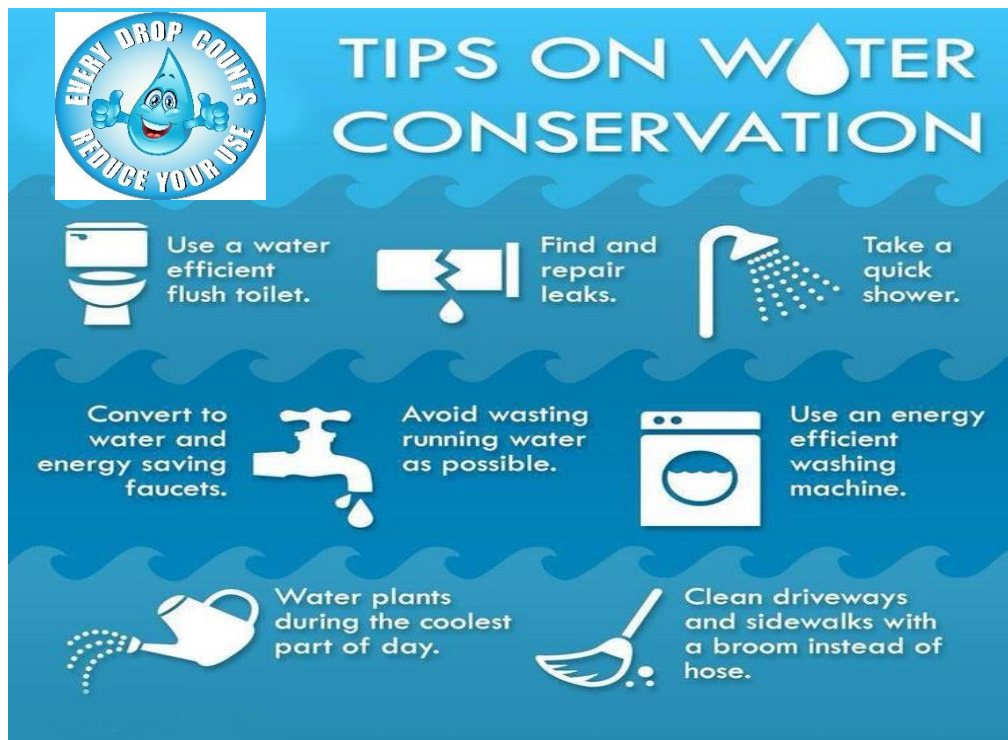
## WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE

The Residents of Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation using water from our Water Systems are requested to take extra conservation measures to reduce unnecessary water consumption and high volume water use from **June 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 until further notice.**



Your cooperation is important as every drop counts! All users are urged, whenever possible, to defer activities which may use large amounts of water, example:  
*Filling Pools, watering lawns, washing vehicles, power washing etc.*

This is also an excellent time to fix leaky faucets, or constantly running toilets etc.



With good user cooperation and conservative use there should be an ample supply of water for normal household use during this period and we hope to avoid any interruption of service.
